Sunday, July 1

We will spend Sunday exploring the world famous Cedar Point theme park. This 365-acre park is the second oldest in the US and is arguably the roller coaster capital of the world! Cedar Point has also received the Golden Ticket Award for "Best Amusement Park in the World" from Amusement Today for 16 consecutive years. Check out coasters like Millennium Force, Wicked Twister, Top Thrill Dragster, and the brand new Steel Vengeance, opening in May 2018 just before we arrive. That night we will check into the Embassy Suites State Street—a beautiful hotel in the heart of the Chicago River North area near all the best attractions and restaurants!

Monday, July 2

That evening we will stop by the 360 Chicago Observation Deck, which will provide you with another unforgettable view of the city.

Wednesday, July 4

We will kickstart July 4th with a relaxing cruise around all three branches of the Chicago River and Lake Michigan. This will be an excellent opportunity to admire the architecture of this one-of-a-kind American city and the architects who designed it! Then we will visit the Art Institute of the Chicago, a one-million-square-foot mega art museum founded in 1879. Containing nearly 300,000 pieces of artwork, the Art Institute has everything: from Edward Hopper and Picasso to a brand new Modern Wing too. Everyone will find something they love at this world-famous museum! That evening, we will check into our Convention hotel in downtown Chicago and kick-off our International Convention!
