

Dues Report



Clubs that did not get their dues in before February 1st are now being suspended. I have been reaching out to your clubs that have not paid as well in an effort to help you all have more paid clubs in your divisions. If your division has any updates, I will continue to send you updated divisional dues reports until DCON so that you can get the most points in your RFL binder.

What's Next for Clubs?

Now that club suspension has begun, here are the next steps for clubs of each status.

Paid: These clubs are set regarding dues for the rest of your current terms!

Suspended: These clubs need to submit dues if they are still meeting. There are no additional fees or paperwork, but they should submit as soon as possible.

Inactive: These clubs need to submit reactivation paperwork and pay a \$23 reactivation fee to return to an active status.

RFL Dues Information

Sections 7 and 8 in your RFL binder focus on dues information for your divison. Here is more infomation on what to include in these folders.

7. Dues collection

The divisional dues report should be sufficient for this section. If you have any emails demonstrating your efforts to encourage dues payments or emails that could explain why a club wasn't able to submit their dues by the deadline, you may include them as well.

8. Club growth

Clubs that appeared between dues reports were chartered or reactivated. Any emails or communication showing your work in the charter/reactivation process can be included in the section. Even if you didn't take part in reativating or chartering a club, you should still include it in the section, and you can still recieve the points. If you have any questions or are not sure if any of your clubs could be included here, let me know and I can send you an email with the official information to use in this section!
